Spotlight on GraniteNet Group: Granite Belt Wildlife Carers Inc.

The Granite Belt Wildlife Carers Incorporated concentrate on caring for our sick and injured local wildlife, and relies primarily on it's dedicated members for wildlife care, rescue, rehabilitation, release and fund raising ventures.

This year they will be providing a veterinary accredited demonstration and workshop day, covering basic first aid, wound maintenance, and symptom diagnosis. We will also be re-running our native plant drive, and showcasing our commitment in the community at the Broadwater Monster Markets and at Gardenfest.

Last year over 70 calls were made to rescue a variety of injured birds, macropods and reptiles, a large percentage of which were vehicle related injuries. So remember to keep your eyes open when on the road, and contact Granite Belt Wildlife Carers if assistance of injured animals is required or if you would like more information on **0418 144 073**

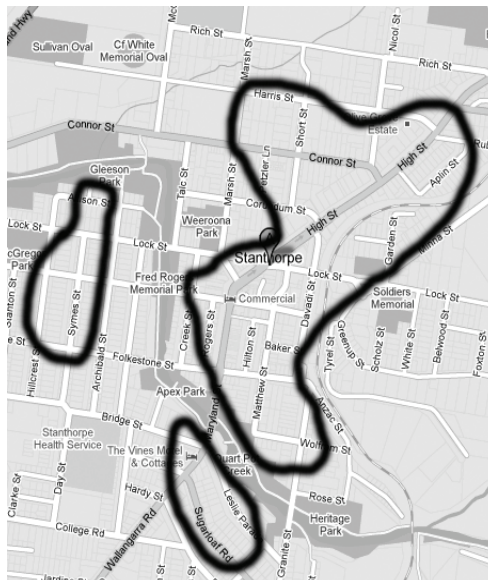
Tomizone

LB: 5 Months.

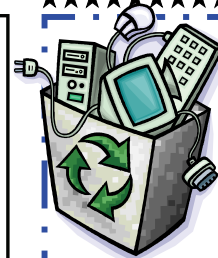
GN: Do you volunteer within any other community groups or organisations?
